

Spring Planting Guide

Boise's average last frost date is May 10

Stagger your plantings to have a multi-week harvest. Cucurbits (cucumbers, melons and squash) and root crops do not like their roots disturbed. It is best to seed in plantable pot, or directly in the ground. Remember, dates are approximate, and can change with seasonal weather.
